

## Security Management Policy

PT Chandra Asri Petrochemical Tbk (PT CAP) and its subsidiaries is an integrated petrochemical complex located in Indonesia. PT CAP is considered to be one of Indonesia's *Obyek Vital Nasional* (OBVITNAS) by the decree of Ministry of Industrial Affairs No. 466/M-IND/Kep/8/2014. Any abnormality, non-conformity, threat and/or disturbance to an OBVITNAS may result in potential disastrous impact on the Country's citizens, economic well-being and development index.

Management of PT Chandra Asri Petrochemical Tbk is committed to implement Security Management System as postulated in a decree from the Indonesian Police Department No. 07/2019 which is to protect the Company's overall assets and its surrounding areas throughout its business operations.

PT CAP's commitment is translated into the following policy:

1. Provide framework to implement Security Management System including establish system to review its objectives and targets which are aligned with this policy
2. Conduct risk analysis of the Company's operational activities and prioritize control of significant security risks as identified in the Security Risk Assessment process
3. Prioritize preemptive and preventive measures, and continuous improvement process of the Security Management System in order to mitigate/eliminate potential disruptions with significant impact to the Company's operational activities
4. Comply and follow related legal requirements, rules, regulations and other applicable provisions related to the implementation of the Security Management System
5. Provide adequate resources, infrastructures and competent employees to maintain the Company's security performance
6. Maintain and regularly review the effectiveness of the Security Management System in accordance with relevant national and/or international standards
7. Communicate this policy to all employees, contractors, suppliers, customers, communities and other stakeholders

This policy is established to protect PT Chandra Asri Petrochemical Tbk and its subsidiaries from any potential failure due to security issue. Thus, all stakeholders and guests must support this policy for the benefit of the Company and the Country.
